

GRADE 1 – 2015

FIRST DAY: 14 January 2015, new Grade 1 2015 learners who did not attend the Grade 1 party in November, and their parents/guardians to meet on the school field at 07:30.

REQUIREMENTS: The end of year nursery school report / latest Grade 1 report will be required on first day of school, no child will be admitted without the report.

STARTING TIME: 07:30 every morning. **PLEASE ENSURE THAT YOUR CHILD IS ON TIME!**

CLOSING TIME: 13:40 (12:00 until end of January 2015)

CLOTHING AND GENERAL APPEARANCE

1. All clothing must be marked! (INCLUDING SHOES). Learners should know where to find their names on items.
2. All school requirements MUST be marked individually.
3. Please ensure that your child has the regulation PET Uniform (School golf shirt, green shorts, white socks, white sports shoes and green jersey). **To be worn for the whole year.** School tracksuit worn in winter only. See reverse side for hours and prices.
4. Hair must be neat. Girls: long hair tied back with green, red or white hair accessories
Boys: short back and sides. No shaved styles are acceptable or steps, braiding or dreadlocks.
5. As our lost property increases weekly by approximately 15-20 jerseys and other items, we appeal to parents to check their children's clothing daily, and to claim items from the lost property room immediately.
6. **No bare feet** in summer.

STATIONERY - Stationery will be provided and remains at school.

MONEY - All money brought to school must be in an envelope with the child's name, class and its purpose. A receipt must be received from the Finance Office for all monies sent to school. Please send the exact amount, teachers will not be able to give change. Each learner will be issued with a neck purse to be able to keep their spending money safe.

CIRCULARS

Please check your child's suitcase daily for circulars. Newsletters go out every Thursday and are also available on the School Communicator and the web page. News, dates and other important items are on the School Communicator. Please ensure that you complete all tear-off slips and return them to school the following day. This is important as this is our only way to communicate with parents.

LUNCH

It is a very long day and your child MUST bring a nourishing lunch and fruit to school for breaks. Treats may be given, but may only be eaten at 2nd break. All Foundation Phase learners will have supervised lunch time at 09:20.

GENERAL

1. No children may ever play on the Jungle Gym without the class-teacher's supervision. At any other time after school there must be parental supervision and the school will not accept responsibility for any injury incurred. Please impress the above-mentioned information upon your children and inform them that only children under the age of 9 may use the Jungle Gym.
2. The child's name, address and telephone number must be on the inside of the lid of the suitcase, as well as on the inside cover of the homework / message book. Please label suitcases on the outside as well. Part of the school readiness is that your child needs to know the abovementioned personal information off by heart.

3. Girls are allowed to wear small gold or silver (no colour stones) stud earrings. **NO OTHER JEWELLERY OR TOYS MAY BE BROUGHT TO SCHOOL.**
4. All stationery requirements, including a suitcase, will be issued to learners on the first day of school.

PLEASE DO NOT PUT PRESSURE ON YOUR CHILD AT ANY TIME, BUT DO SHOW AN INTEREST IN WHAT HE/SHE IS DOING AT SCHOOL AT ALL TIMES.
