(Referred to as the Physical Education (PE) and sports practice uniform)

- Green Glenstantia golf-shirt (tucked in)
- School regulation green shorts
- White sports shoes with plain short white socks or
- Dark brown leather sandals without socks (<u>not</u> bronze, beige or gold)
- Dark green jersey or sleeveless v-neck pullover
- School tracksuit (worn in winter only from May to August 2022)
- Green school hat Compulsory for Grade R only and provided by the school

# **SUMMER UNIFORM** for Grades 3 – 7 only **BOYS**:

- Khaki shorts
- Short-sleeved, open-necked khaki shirt (tucked in)
- Dark brown leather sandals without socks (not bronze, beige or gold) or
- Black lace-up shoes with long dark green socks
- Dark green jersey or sleeveless v-neck pullover

# **GIRLS**:

- Tartan skirt/Tartan skort. Length of skirt maximum 5cm above the knee
- White short-sleeved open necked shirt (tucked in)
- Dark brown leather sandals without socks (not bronze, beige or gold) or
- Black shoes with white ankle socks
- Dark green jersey or sleeveless v-neck pullover

# <u>WINTER UNIFORM</u> for Grades 3 – 7 (from May – August 2022)

# **BOYS**:

- School tracksuit
- Tracksuit worn with white long-sleeved shirt (tucked in), or khaki button-up short-sleeved shirt (tucked in), both with green school tie
- Dark green socks and black lace-up shoes
- A plain dark green, white or red scarf may be worn in winter OR:
- Long grey flannels, long-sleeved white shirt (tucked in) and school tie
- Dark green socks with black lace-up shoes
- Dark green jersey or sleeveless v-neck pullover

# **GIRLS:**

- Tartan skirt/Tartan skort. Length of skirt maximum 5cm above the knee
- White long-sleeved shirt (tucked in) and green tie
- Long green socks and black shoes
- Dark green cardigan or jersey or sleeveless v-neck pullover
- A plain dark green, white or red scarf may be worn in winter OR:
- School tracksuit in place of the tartan skirt

**OPTIONAL:** A dark green drimac may only be worn over the school jersey when it's raining.

**PREFECTS**: Prefects wear a special prefects' tie.

#### PHYSICAL EDUCATION (PE) AND SPORTS PRACTICE UNIFORM

Grades 3 – 7 Boys and Girls (PE Uniform to be worn for PE and sport practice only):

- School regulation green shorts (only the shorts bought from the tuck-shop and official stockist).
- Green Glenstantia golf shirt (tucked in)
- White sports shoes
- Short white socks
- Tracksuit worn over PE uniform in winter.

# **General Notes:**

- ✓ Physical Education Uniform (PE) must be worn to school for the whole day on the day that learners have Physical Education. (Tracksuit worn over PE uniform in winter.)
- ✓ Physical Education Uniform is only available from the Tuck-shop, Mondays Fridays, between 08:00 13:15 excluding break times.
- ✓ Learners participating in a sporting code may wear the official school tracksuit in winter and at evening meetings.

# PERSONAL APPEARANCE

Exerts below are taken from the Code of Conduct, which is subject to revision without notification. It can be found on the School Communicator, School's website and in the Information Brochure issued on the learner's 1<sup>st</sup> day of school.

The following important principle's must be noted and adhered to:

 All learners who attend Glenstantia Primary School are ambassadors for the school and must, therefore, be correctly attired and groomed at all times. This includes any learner whilst attired

in school uniform or out of uniform, and who can through whatever means whatsoever be identified as a learner at Glenstantia Primary School, whilst in any public place and during or after school hours.

• Sports uniform, as stipulated for each sporting code, is to be worn to matches/galas/events.

The following dress code and rules regarding personal appearance must be noted and adhered to:

### **Rules specific to Female Learners**

- Skirts / skorts may not be more than 5cm above the kneecap.
- <u>Earrings</u>: Girls are allowed to wear small gold or silver stud earrings and a plain wristwatch. No other jewellery may be worn. No beads or adornments may be worn.
- <u>Hair:</u> Hair must be neat. No coloured or dyed hair is permitted. Braids or dreadlocks are not to be coloured. Hair that touches the collar, or is longer, must be tied back and clipped away from the eyes. Green, white or red ribbons, bobbles or hair bands may be used. No beads may be plaited into the hair. Long braids are regarded as loose hair and must be tied back. Hair may be layered and must have an even flow from long to short. No distinguishable lines that have been cut/shaved in, may be visible.
- Whether straight or curly, hair must be groomed and clean, must be neat and appropriate for a primary school learner.
- Nails should not be longer than the end of the fingers. Nail varnish is not permitted.

### Rules specific to Male Learners

- <u>Hair:</u> Whether straight or curly must be groomed and clean, must be neat and appropriate for a primary school learner. Hair may not touch the ears or collars of any garment, (shirt, blazer or other garment). Hair may be layered if professionally cut, notwithstanding there may not be a discernible difference in hair length as it appears on the top of the head in relation to the sides of the head, i.e. the sides may not be shaved short in relation to the hair on the top of the head. There must be an even flow from long to short.
- No hair colourants or other products, i.e. gels or similar, may be applied to the learner's hair. The learner's hair colour must be natural.
- No "styles" are permitted, i.e. corn-rows, flip-up fringes, braids or dreadlocks, frizzed or teased out afro styles, modern fashion styles.
- Naturally curly hair must be cut short in order that it does not touch the ears or collars as
  applies to straight hair; similarly, the hair on top of the head must be of a similar length in
  relation to the hair on the sides of the head as previously stipulated.
- NB: Appropriate hair styles must be maintained at any function where the learner represents the school. Whether in school hours or after hours.
- Wrist watches only, may be worn with the school uniform. NO other jewellery may be worn.

Requests for exceptions on the grounds of certain religious symbols or cultural practices must be made in writing for consideration by the School Management Team.

#### **Civvies Day Dress Code for Boys and Girls in all Grades:**

- No T-Shirts with unsuitable logos
- No tattered / torn jeans or cut-off shorts
- No visible underwear with low slung jeans
- No fancy hairstyles
- No pajamas, gowns or slippers
- No high-heeled shoes
- No make-up or nail polish
- No caps / hats
- No low front tops showing cleavage
- No mini-skirts or skimpy short skirts
- No bare midriffs
- No jewellery (watch only)
- No shorts shorter than a school skirt (max 5cm above the knee)
- No shoe-string / strappy tops with bra straps visible.
